

CARE PACKAGES TO ROCA: "I was a prisoner and you visited me." You may not be able to visit a detention center in San Antonio, but you can still do something to make a difference for our friends caught up in the immigration system there. Roca de Refugio is inviting the rest of the conference to provide care packages for families who have a loved one in detention or in the deportation process. Possible items include: For adults: Cozy socks, cookies, hot chocolate, tea, mugs, candles, face masks, lotions, journal and pen, notes of support, etc. For kids: Stuffed animals, cozy socks, soft blanket, candy, cookies, coloring book/notebook and pen, activities book (with no or little English), etc. Pastor Randy, Carole Suderman and Brenda Fox will be traveling to San Antonio in November – we hope to be able to pack suitcases of items to take with us! Bring your items to the church, and place in the box by the coat closet in the sanctuary. Thank you! Gracias!
