





Hunter "Patch" Adams

"My first introduction to the United States came shortly after I moved to Virginia, from an army base in Germany. While I was living in Virginia, I saw a sign on a public drinking fountain saying "Whites Only". Living in a society with such hatred, and seeing the sign crystalized what I felt after I moved to the United States. No one tore the sign down because it became so normalized, and I didn't want to live in a world in


which this degree of hatred was seen as somehow "normal". I got in trouble with my classmates and was beaten up for standing up to the racism that surrounded me.

At 18, I decided to be six qualities: happy, funny, loving, cooperative, creative, and thoughtful. These six qualities allow me to be an instrument for peace, justice, and care for all people and nature. It was being present, and hearing Dr. King's speech in Washington DC that later gave me hope. I decided I should make my own nonviolent revolution! In order to become an instrument for peace, justice and care I read thousands of books. I needed to understand so I could create solutions.

I am a Doctor, but above all else I consider myself an activist for peace, justice and care for all people. My life has been a dance with humanity."
